Idaho Power Company Academic Excellence Scholarships

DEADLINE: March 1, 2008

- Requirements
 - Must have an accumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher
 - Must enroll full-time in an Idaho or Oregon college, university or technical school.
 - Application must be submitted in a report folder.
 - Application must be post marked by March 1, 2008.
 - All required information must be included with the application at the time of submission.

College of Southern Idaho Scholarship application

DEADLINE: March 1, 2008

- Requirements
 - Student must apply for admission to CSI
 - Applicant must plan to attend CSI full-time (12 credits or more)
 - Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0

Application is used for all CSI Foundation scholarships and Idaho Promise B. Applications are available in the counseling office.

Hispanic Business Association 2008 Scholarship Program

DEADLINE: March 1, 2008

The Hispanic Business Association (HBA) is a non-profit organization dedicated to the improvement of educational opportunities for Hispanic students.

- General Guidelines
 - The number of scholarships awarded is determined each year by the HBA's Board of Directors. Proceeds for this scholarship program come from our annual golf tournament: "The Richard G. Cortez Jalapeno Open". Scholarship recipients will be asked to participate as a volunteer during the tournament scheduled for July of 2008.
 - Recipients must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours or have full-time status as an undergraduate or graduate student in an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning.

- Award recipients are selected based on the following factors.
 - § Academic performance based on the most recent official transcript.
 - § Essay
 - § Extracurricular activities/work experience, which reflect leadership, initiative, motivation, etc.
 - § Recommendations from teachers, business contacts, clergy, etc.
- General Requirements.
 - Minimum GPA of 2.5
 - U.S. citizen or permanent resident for at least one year and of Hispanic descent.
 - Documents must be submitted with scholarship application.

Auxiliary Inc. Health Career Scholarship DEADLINE: March 1, 2008

- Requirements
 - Must be enrolled in or entering in a Medical Field at an approved nursing school, college, university, or trade program within Idaho
 - Applicant must take at least 12 units per semester
 - Must maintain a “B” average or better for all school work
 - Applicant lives in areas served by West Valley Medical Center or Satellite clinics.
 - Applicant must provide a transcript of grades for 3 previous semesters of study.
 - Applicant must provide 3 letters of recommendation. Two from core studies instructors and one from a counselor, employer, or minister. These letters are to be sent directly to the Auxiliary Scholarship Committee at address on application.

University of Idaho Multicultural Scholars Program DEADLINE: March 7, 2008

The College of Agricultural and Life Sciences at the University of Idaho offers five scholarships to students from ethnically diverse backgrounds. Scholarships are worth approximately \$4,500 per year, typically covers tuition, books and fees, can be renewable for up to four years.

- Requirements
 - Must be a US citizen AND an Alaska Native, Asian American, African American, American Indian, Hispanic/Latino American, or Pacific Islander.
 - Must be admitted to the University of Idaho for the fall 2008 semester
 - Declare a major in the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences

- Submit a complete application packet to the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences by March 7th, 2008.

SEMI Pacific Northwest Scholarship Program

DEADLINE: March 15, 2008

- Requirements
 - Applicant must be in their senior year of high school and plan to pursue a degree in a high technology related field upon college entrance.
 - Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better at their graduating high school
 - Applicant must be pursuing a major such as: Mathematics, Electrical Engineering, computer Engineering, Computer Science, Physics, Mechanical Engineering, Chemical Engineering, or an Education degree with a focus on teaching math or science.
 - Preference will be given to applicants who have
 - A work history
 - Can demonstrate financial need (based on FAFSA report)
 - Volunteered and shown leadership experience in civic or professional associations
 - Participated in SEMI High Tech U and/or FIRST Robotics.

DEADLINE: April 4, 2008

The Dave Kludt- ALC Natural Resource Scholarship is dedicated in memory of Dave Kludt, former Idaho Logging Safety supervisor, who was killed in a car accident in 2006. This scholarship will be given to a student, related to an ALC member that is planning to pursue studies beyond high school in a natural resource related field. \$1,000 award.

- Requirements
 - To be eligible for the \$1,000 award, applicants must demonstrate that they are related to an ALC member
 - Must also show that they are planning to attend college or technical school in a field of study that will return them to work in the natural resource arena
 - Examples of fields of study are: diesel mechanics, truck driving, machine operation, forestry, forestry technician, biology, hydrologist, or law with intent to practice in the natural resource field in defense of logging and forest management.

- Requirements

- Must be taking at least 12 credits at an accredited college or university, including community colleges or career colleges.

Each applicant must submit a completed application form, an official transcript, three letters of reference, and a personal profile that includes goals, and may include any work experience, volunteer work, or other background material the applicant considers pertinent.  - Have an un-weighted grade point average of at least 3.5 on a scale of 4.0
 - Plan to major in Engineering (Electrical, Chemical, Material Science, or Mechanical), Physics, or Chemistry at an accredited four-year college or university
 - Have demonstrated leadership in school, work and/or extracurricular activities.

- Requirements:
 - Students must be directly from an Idaho high school.
 - Students must be tentatively admitted by the March 1st Priority deadline.
 - Minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA on 7th semester and final transcripts.
 - At LCSC, students must maintain a 3.0 GPA and register for 12 credits each semester.

Provost Scholarship: \$500/yr. for two years
Promise Scholarship: \$500 (freshman and sophomore years)

- Requirements:
 - Students must be directly from an Idaho high school.
 - Students must be tentatively admitted by the March 1st priority deadline.
 - Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA on 7th semester and final transcripts.
 - At LCSC, students must maintain a 3.0 GPA and register for 12 credits each semester.

- Be pursuing or plan to pursue your first undergraduate or graduate degree
- Must apply for federal financial aid using FAFSA
- Plan to enroll full-time as an undergraduate or graduate student in a degree seeking program at a U.S. accredited institution in the U.S., Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands, or Guam in the upcoming academic year.
